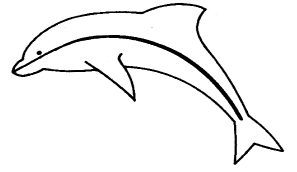

'Stoneways' Open Poole Station RNLI 200 Pursuit Race

Saturday June 8th 2024

Start Times.

Start times for individual boats will be according to their rating and are detailed on the Open Poole station RNLI Pursuit Race Start Times sheet -

Course Instructions.

These will be given on CH M2 approx. 10 mins and 5 mins before the Scheduled Start Time of the race, at the Start Time, and approximately every 15 mins thereafter until the last competitor has started.

The start location will be in Poole Bay and will be advised 30 mins before the first start and then at the time indicated above.

Sound Signals.

These will be made with the Warning, Preparatory, One-minute and Starting signals for the Scheduled Start Time, and one sound signal will be made every 15 mins thereafter until the last competitor has started.

Time Checks

These will be given on CH M2 (161.425 MHz [P4]) every 15 mins following the Start until the last Competitor has started.

Individual Recalls.

The Race Committee will endeavour to notify premature starters on CH M2. No other recall signals will be made.

Finishing.

The Finishing Line will be a moving line that will be established at Finish Time (First Start + 180 mins), in the vicinity of the leading boat.

After the finishing signal all competing boats shall maintain their relative positions and continue to sail towards the finishing line. The finishing line boat/s will motor back past the fleet recording finishing positions. Competitors are warned that if the final leg is a beat then they should be near the rhumb line at the finishing time or the finishing boats may miss them.
